Stone in the Garden

Bar Harbor, ME – Join the Beatrix Farrand Society for an afternoon with Gordon Hayward. The nationally recognized garden designer will speak from 1:00-3:00 pm on Monday, July 2, 2012, at Garland Farm. Hayward, an expert in stonework and a master landscaper, will present an inspiring look at stone, one of the defining components of gardens.

Stone can transform a garden by providing structure and a sense of permanence. Stone provides the perfect foil to plants, whether installed as retaining or free-standing walls, as terraces or walkways, as bold standing stones, or as boulders at the edge of a small stream. Through stunning photos of his work, Hayward will demonstrate the many creative and practical ways that stone can give a garden a feeling of timelessness, structure and solidity. Going beyond aesthetics, he will discuss the practical concerns about the proper way to lay and set stone in the garden. Celebrate the spectacular geology of Maine by adding stone to your garden!

Hayward's book, "Stone in the Garden" will be available for sale, and he will sign copies on site. The New York Times' Verlyn Klinkenborg called this book "the best book on stonework to come along in many years."

Garland Farm is located at 475 Bay View Drive, Bar Harbor ME. *From the island bridge*, drive east on Route 3 toward Bar Harbor, approximately two miles. Turn left on Bay View Drive, then immediately turn left into the parking area. Follow the footpath to the barn. *From Bar Harbor*, travel north on Route 3. After passing through Salisbury Cove, turn right on Bay View Drive (6.8 miles beyond College of the Atlantic), then immediately left into the parking area.
